Further to our acknowledgement, we can confirm that Oxford City Council can advise as follows in response to your Freedom of Information Request received on 2 April:

Request

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request the following information in the format provided below.

How many cumulative working days did council staff spend working from home in 2022-23?

There is no data held for this question.

We do not capture, and record data of employee's days worked at home.

How much the council spent on work from home related costs for council workers (i.e. home desktop screens/office chairs etc) in 2022-23?

In 22-23 financial year we spent £7,270.17 VAT inc. on furniture for home working.

We hold no data on separate spend related to home desktop screens for employees to work from home.

If you disagree with any part of the response to your request, you are entitled to ask the Council for an internal review of the decision(s) made.
